The Venue

The church is large with a good acoustic and is frequently used as a Ryedale Festival venue. It has comfortable seating – no pews! – and offers excellent visibility. There is a large car park with overflow area plus on-street parking. Toilet facilities (including an accessible toilet) are available in Church House which is adjacent. There is a ramp for wheelchair access into the church and into the adjacent building and toilets.
